

All lumber used for the backboards is KILN-DRIED and pressure treated. Our virgin polyurethane foam maintains its high resiliency to prevent foam pad "sag." High Visibility yellow guide stripes are standard on all models, as well as galvanized steel mounting hardware.

HIGH QUALITY FABRICS

The dock seal cover fabric is a very critical component in determining the useful life of a dock seal. Comfort Tech offers a variety of vinyl fabrics in different weights and colors designed to suit every dock situation from light volume traffic to the even the heaviest.


FOAM HEAD PAD

A 12" wide foam filled, wood backed head pad is standard on Comfort Tech Dock Seals for doors 9'-0" high or less. Three sided foam protection provides the most effective seal at the loading dock door. Extra wide head pads 18" to 24" are available to allow varied truck height coverage. As an option, a chain weighted drop flap can be sewn to the underside of the foam head pad to service an occasional lower truck and is held up and out of the way with Velcro tabs.




WEDGED SIDE PADS


Wedge cut side pads extend foam only into the door opening to effectively seal the trailer without subjecting wood backboards to damage from passing loads.



INCLINED or DECLINED DRIVE

Tapered dock seal side pads are available to accommodate sloped drives. Even truck contact and compression into the foam pads can help to reduce excessive wear at the top or bottom of the dock seals.






"C" CURTAIN STYLE HEADER

The "C" series curtain header dock seals are designed to accommodate higher dock doors and varying truck heights.

The "C" series header can also be equipped with extra wear areas at critical truck contact points to reduce wear. Curtain headers are used when door sizes exceed 9'0" high. The head curtain extends over and down the face of the side pads to cover a wide range of truck heights. By adding Velcro splits with a rope pull-up system the "C" Curtain Header becomes adjustable.




FACING OPTIONS

A second layer of material can be sewn over the base fabric to provide some additional protection on the face of the dock seal. Available in your choice of fabrics to help provide longer dock seal life.

WEAR PLEATS

Wear Pleats provide extra protection on the face of the dock seal. Wear Pleats are overlapping layers of material sewn to the base fabric of the side pads as well as the head pads or head curtains and can increase durability and extend the dock seal's life. Available in two configurations with a 4" exposure as well as an 8" exposure. Custom exposures are also available upon request.
